3 November 2009

The meeting was brought to order by Adam Clement at 6:35 pm., with Officers and Board Members Merle MacGregor, Jeff Penner, Guy Nicholas, Roy Domke, Steve Cole and me, Phil Leech. Members absent were Ian Rickard and Patrick O'Halloran. The meeting was held at Guy Nicholas' Office, Adobe Systems.

- The Christmas Party was reviewed. Roy told us that a meeting with Donna Healey from Trentadue was scheduled in the next few days. Purpose of the meeting is to resolve questions about number of tables, caterer etc for the party.

Wine will be available and we will have to sell tickets to members. There was a suggestion that since we aren't planning to give plaques to each officer that we could give a bottle of wine to each officer. Guy will supply the computer and projector for the video presentation and Roy will bring a screen. Phil plans to mail the invitations in about a week.

are about 8 fourth or fifth grade students that are participating and we met with them after school hours. Patrick had prepared kits to build small tissue and balsa planes that will be rubber powered as an introduction to learning about the principles of flight. We plan to meet on Tuesday afternoons until the demonstration of six specific flight performances is performed on Feb 27 at Santa Rosa High School competing with other teams from area schools. This is certainly a demonstration of community involvement and contribution for WCF.

- Our website has been serving as a means of communication for some of members by the use of the Web Site Forum.

- Adam wondered whether the website might develop into a substitute for the newsletter.

- Adam reviewed the standings for the Pylon Race T-28 class with Jon Stychno leading with 120 points followed by Adam 113, Steve Cole 93, Patick 87, and Jeff Penner at 84 points. Warbirds have Steve Cole at 102, Jon Stychno 90 and Adam with 86 points.

- Steve discussed the possibility of creating a Reno racing class based on Reno racers of the past.

- Jeff proposed that a special "Learn to Fly Day" be created for Pack #133 Cub Scouts and Troop #55 Boy Scouts for Sunday Nov 22 at 10AM and everyone agreed with his proposal.
