- Reviewed upcoming Xmas party, large turnout expected.
- Agreement to pay for Julio Alvarez' meal as a thank you for all his efforts for the club in 2009. Motioned by Adam Clement and seconded by Jeff Penner. Motion passed.
- Prizes have been purchased and winners will get to pick their prize.
- It was agreed that in the event of a tie in the final results based on points the racer with the greatest number of first place finishes will be the winner and if necessary second or third place finishes will be counted to decide the winner.
- Pylon Racing. (editors note: I pulled the rules for items 1 & 2 as a full list of rules will be published shortly)
 1. T-28 class will remain for pylon racing in 2010.
 2. War bird class will also remain, members are encouraged to build their planes like Reno Racers, but this is not mandatory.
 3. Suggested class 12th scale using 30 size nitro motor, wingspan must be 36-40 inches. Steve Cole will be investigating this.

- Swap Meet: Adam Clement wants to organize a swap meet for April 2010. Suggestion made to coordinate with Wayne at Prop Busters for this event to possible combine the two club events.
- Recommendation that nominations for President and other officers need to be submitted to the membership one month prior to the annual general meeting. Board to discuss this and ways to amend the bylaws.
